

Terms and Conditions for Friends of Montgomery Street Park Photography Competition 2011

Introduction

Entries are invited for a photographic competition on the theme 'My Montgomery Street Park' to celebrate the 2011 Summer Fair.

By entering the Competition you confirm that you accept these Terms & Conditions and undertake to comply with them. If you are under 16, you must obtain your parent or guardian's permission prior to submitting your entry.

Entries

Images may be taken using digital or film. Images may be colour, or black and white. All entries, whether taken digitally or on film, must be submitted electronically to the email address friendsofmsp@gmail.com

Scans from film or prints are acceptable. Entries will not be accepted by post or hand. Entries must be JPEG files of no less than 250k and no more than 1Mb in file size.

You must include your name, address and contact telephone number and age if under 18. Your information will only be used for the purposes of this competition.

Retouching / manipulation of digital images is acceptable, provided that all works are original works and not copies of any other persons' work.

You may enter an image taken at any time in the past twelve months from the date of entry and you may enter a maximum of 3 images, but each one must be submitted separately.

You cannot enter an image that has previously been entered into or has won another photography competition.

Closing date

The Competition will open for entries at Midday on 17th July 2011 and will close at Midday on 13th August 2011. Entries received after this deadline will not be accepted.

No responsibility can be accepted for network, computer hardware or software failures of any kind which may restrict or delay the submission of an entry.

Prizes and judging

Judging will take place after 13th August 2011 and the winners will be announced on the 20th August 2011 at the Montgomery Street Park Summer Fun Day.

Our panel of judges will assess all entries and then select the winning images.

The judges' decision is final and no discussion or correspondence can be entered into in respect of their decision.

By entering the Competition you agree to comply with these Terms & Conditions and you release The Friends of Montgomery Street Park, The Edinburgh Council and all other parties associated with Montgomery Street Park from and against all claims and

damages arising from or in connection with your participation in the Competition.

Details relating to any prizes will be sent to the winner within 30 days of the winner being announced.

Restrictions on Images

The Authority will decline to accept (and may destroy without further notice) any images which in its opinion are obscene, blasphemous, libellous or otherwise unlawful, or which contain racist, sexist, discriminatory, violent or otherwise inappropriate images.

You must have the consent of the appropriate parent/guardian before submitting any image of a child or young person under the age of 18.

Copyright and usage

By submitting images to the competition, you confirm and warrant that:

- you are the sole author of each entry and that it is your original work
- you own the copyright and all other intellectual property rights in each image
- you have the permission of those pictured in the image (or, where the image shows any persons under 18, the consent of their parent or guardian) for the usage rights required in the section on licensing below
- you have not licensed or disposed of any rights in the image that would conflict with uses to be made in the licensing section below
- you agree to indemnify The Friends of Montgomery Street Park from and against all actions, claims, demands, proceedings, damages, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect of infringement or alleged infringement of copyright
- you agree to take part in any post-competition publicity.

By entering the competition, you grant The Friends of Montgomery Street Park a non-exclusive, irrevocable licence to reproduce, enlarge, publish or exhibit, on any media, your image(s). This may include, but is not limited to:

- news coverage of the competition
